THE CHRONICLES OF HELL

in London during the Summer Olympic Games in 2012

Dear friend,

This letter comes with warm greetings from MFF, the American photographer who was awarded with "A National Hero of Ichkeria" in 2012. MFF has not only devoted himself to capturing truth in his photography of natural landscapes, but also of the truth about man's inhumanity to man. He also sends his sincere request for your help along with his greetings. The international project using his award winning photographs of the terrible things done to the people of Caucasus will be described in this letter.

MFF, along admirers of his art, have begun to prepare for the exhibition-requiem called "The Chronicles of Hell." The exposition of the horrendous tragedy against the Caucasian peoples will be shown London during the Summer Olympic Games in 2012. The whole world will also be watching more than just the Olympic Games.

More than forty two thousand children were killed. And thirty percent of the Chechen people were torn by cruel Russian bombs and missiles. This was a massive genocide that never went to trial as the Nazis injustices did at Nuremburg. But this has not been forgotten.

Many people of good will who want this covered up segment of history to be exposed. They have agree to volunteer their time to be involved in the international project and exhibition of "The Chronicles of Hell", a photographic exposed of this atrocity. They would like you to join them in spirit, with your prayer and your financial support of this project.

Printing a photo exhibition of large format (half the size of an average person) will cost \$80.00. AN ACE

"One eighteen-year old girl was killed by two missiles fired by a Russian pilot. This is her story. Three girls went to get some water from the river. On their way back they saw a plane circling in the sky above them. Two of the girls ran away, but the third put down her buckets and called after them saying, "Come back, they won't do us any harm!" The plane made three circles and when the dust settled, the girl could be seen lying on the ground with a bomb crater on her right and on her left. She never recovered consciousness and died in the hospital. So many women, men and children were left without their legs and arms."

The Russians have succeeded in installing a pro-Moscow Chechen regime, and eliminating most of the more prominent Chechen separatist leaders, including former president Aslan Maskhadov and leading warlord Shamil Basayev; the war bolstered the domestic popularity of Vladimir Putin, who launched the military campaign one month after becoming Russian prime minister. By now, large-scale fighting has been replaced by low-level skirmishing, hit and run attacks and bombings targeting federal troops and forces of the regional government, with the violence often spilling over into adjacent regions.
